I am delighted to invite you to our Parent and Carer Evening for Year 10 students on Thursday 5th March 2025 from 4pm to 7pm in our main hall. The window for booking appointments will open on Wednesday 25th February at 4pm.

How do I book appointments?

You have received with this letter instructions on how to sign up for appointments in Arbor, both on the app and the website. You have also received your login details for Arbor to register an account. Once you are registered, you will be able to use this system to book future appointments for all your children at Greyfriars.

Each appointment slot is 5 minutes. We recommend that you leave a 5 minute gap between each appointment to give you time to move to the next appointment. If there are no slots remaining for a member of staff, it is likely that they are fully booked; we are sorry that we are unable to offer additional appointments so we highly recommend booking early.

These meetings are an important opportunity for you to gain an insight into the progress your child has made so far this year and to talk to their teachers about how to support them further. We feel it is essential to attend and this is especially important at the start of GCSEs.
